Application Form

The mission of the TPC Academic Scholarship is to encourage and support students attending four-year accredited colleges/universities, or graduate schools, whose life accomplishments have demonstrated their commitment to introducing people to Jesus, including them in His church, imitating His life, igniting service in His name, and inspiring glory for God.

The TPC Academic Scholarship(s) will be awarded based upon student commitment to the TPC Mission Statement*; merit and/or financial need also will be considered. Applicants must be TPC covenant partners, children of covenant partners, students active in TPC's youth group, or students active in TPC's ministries. Finalists will be interviewed.

Scholarship checks will be distributed upon proof of college enrollment. Number and amount of awards are variable. Renewal applications will be considered.

Application process: **Email** completed the Templeton Presbyterian Church Scholarship Application (available on church's website) and attach the following:

- Essay (1 typewritten page): demonstrate how you have lived and will live a life consistent with the TPC Mission Statement.
- Letters of recommendation: two letters of recommendation (one that addresses academic accomplishments and one that addresses your character)
- Transcript: an unofficial copy of your transcript
- Copy—if available—of your FAFSA confirmation page indicating your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

May 1, 2018 is the deadline for receipt of completed emailed application and all required attachments by the church office, firstpres@fpctempleton.org, attention TPC Scholarship Committee.
